

DIVISIONS: For competitions purposes, the field will be broken down into the following groups:
Girls – 9 & Under*, 12 & Under, 13 – 15, 16 – 18, Gatorade Masters**
Boys – 8 & Under*, 10 & Under, 11 – 12, 13 – 14, 15 – 16, 17 – 18, Gatorade Masters**
*6 hole divisions conducted at select locations only
** Gatorade Master Divisions conducted at select locations only

REFUNDS: Refunds will only be granted to those whose requests are received **FORTY-EIGHT (48)** hours prior to the start of the event. The request must be submitted via an e-mail, phone call or message, or written note to Golf House Kentucky. Requests should be directed to the Junior Golf program at Golf House Kentucky. **ALL REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AT THE END OF THE KGA-PGA, INC. JUNIOR GOLF TOURNAMENT SEASON. THE MEMBERSHIP FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.**

WITHDRAWS: Participants must notify Golf House Kentucky **FORTY-EIGHT (48)** hours prior to the tournament they wish to withdraw from. A player failing to properly withdraw from a tournament and/or not showing up, will forfeit the entry fee and may be suspended from the next tournament. Any subsequent violation of this policy will result in suspension from PJGT events.

COURSE CARE: All players are expected to help maintain the condition of the golf course by repairing ball marks, raking bunkers, replacing divots, picking up and disposing of trash, etc. **Any abuse to the course or other club facilities will result in disqualification and suspension of one (1) event.** All players and parents are encouraged to thank the host club, staff, and volunteers for their support of junior golf.

RULES OF PLAY: The 2010 – 2011 USGA Rules of Golf shall govern all play. Supplemental rules of play will be provided (if needed) at each site.

ELECTRONICS: Participants are prohibited from using electronic devices during the round. Cellular phones, portable music players, etc. should be turned off while participating. The use of Electronic Measuring Devices is prohibited for both players and spectators.

POINTS SYSTEM: Each Pepsi Junior Golf Tour event is a competition and points will be awarded based on how a golfer finishes in each age group. The following breakdown will be used:

1st Place	100 points	
2nd Place	85 points	Points will be added then split if there is a tie for any
3rd Place	75 points	place other than first
4th Place	65 points	
5th Place	55 points	Points will double for the Tournament of Champions
6th Place	45 points	
7th Place	35 points	
8th Place	25 points	
9th Place	15 points	
10th Place	5 points	

T.O.C.: The Pepsi Tournament of Champions (T.O.C.) is the year-end, 36-hole, invitational tournament for junior golfers who have qualified based on the following criteria:

- Have finished in 1st place of their age division at a Pepsi Junior Golf Tour event
- Have finished within 100 points of the division leader after the 28 Pepsi Junior Golf Tour events

*Invitations will be mailed out after the final Pepsi Junior Golf Tour event. Entry fee into the Pepsi Tournament of Champions is \$65 for 36 holes and \$55 for 18 holes and includes two rounds of golf, luncheon after the second round, and awards.
