

Mountain Dew Junior Series

The Mountain Dew Junior Series is a group of events conducted for boys ages 13 – 18 and girls ages 14 – 18 as of the tournament date. These events offer junior golfers the opportunity to get back on the course after a cold winter break and rekindle friendships they might have made from last year.

Kicking off this year's Mountain Dew Junior Series is the 2nd Annual Team Championship to be held Big Spring Country Club. This event was a great success last year and we are hoping for an even better event in 2008. Pick a partner and sign up for this event, but make sure your partner is in the same age group as you. This event will be an alternate shot, Chapman style format. Both player A and B will tee off, player A will then hit a shot using player B's ball and player B will hit a shot using player A's ball. Both players then decide which ball to use and finish the hole by using only that ball. Whichever ball is selected to finish the hole, the player who did not hit the second shot plays the third shot. Sound confusing? Maybe a little, but once you get going it is a fun and exciting way to play team golf.

ELIGIBILITY: The Mountain Dew Junior Series is open to any boy age 13 - 18 and any girl age 14 – 18 as of the date of each tournament.

ENTRY PROCESS: To register for the Mountain Dew Junior Series, applicants may either a) visit our website at www.kygolf.org and complete the online entry process or b) fill out the enclosed entry form, making sure all information is properly entered and correct and mail to Golf House Kentucky. Online entry and paper entry will start being accepted at Golf House Kentucky starting at 10:00 a.m. – Monday, February 4, 2008. Applications will not be accepted prior to this date and will not be accepted via fax or by phone.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries will be accepted via the internet through our website or by standard mail until 5:00 p.m. one week prior to each event. In the event that the tournament is not full, entries will be accepted until the tournament is full.

AGE GROUPS: For competition purposes, the field will be broken down into the following age groups: Girls 14 – 15, 16 – 18 and Boys 13 – 14, 15 – 16, and 17 –18.
